Welcome to the chorus program at Evans Elementary! Fourth grade students must fulfill a district requirement to be in chorus in fourth grade. Fifth and sixth grade students may choose to participate in chorus as an elective. In this handout you will find everything you need to know about your child's involvement in chorus. I am looking forward to making music with your child!

GOALS: These are some of the goals students will achieve through participation in chorus:

- 1. understand the use and care of the voice as a musical instrument
- 2. use correct breathing and tuneful singing
- 3. pronounce words clearly
- 4. recognize and use music symbols and terms found in sheet music
- 5. work with others to reach performance expectations by:
 - a. being a positive and productive member of the chorus
 - b. showing commitment to rehearsals and performances

EXPECTATIONS:

To be responsible, students in chorus will:

- Use their best singing voice
- Take good care of their sheet music and chorus folder

To be respectful, students in chorus will:

- Listen while someone else is singing or speaking
- Raise their hand when they need to speak to the teacher

To be safe, students in chorus will:

- Sit or stand in their assigned spot.
- Keep hands, feet, folders, to themselves at all times.
