Budget Calendar First Steps

- ➤ Official work begins on the 2023-2024 budget after approval of the Budget Development Calendar by the Board of Education
 - Preliminary Equipment Requests
 - ➤ New Staffing
 - > Curriculum Proposals
 - ➤ In-Service
 - > Summer Work

Compilation & Review – Next Steps

- > Refer to Board of Education (BOE) goals when building the budget
- ➤ Is reflective of the Mission Statement and Core Values
- ➤ Administration goals accounted for when building the budget
- ➤ Long-term Financial Planning based on available information and prudent estimates
- ➤ Awareness of community expectations of WCSD schools
- > Evaluate overall economic climate both locally and nationally

Compilation & Review – Next Steps

- ➤ Utilize Board of Education meetings for community input
- ➤ Information sharing with Board of Education
 - Allows for administration to build a preliminary budget, component by component, with Board of Education study sessions, as needed.
- Include pertinent revenue funding sources in the General Fund Budget discussions (e.g.: tax cap compliance, federal stimulus dollars, New York State (NYS) projections, alternative funding sources such as Payments In Lieu of Taxes (PILOTS), etc.)
- Discussion on possible referendums to be added to the ballot (e.g.: School Vehicle Replacement Plan, Capital Project, and/or any other topics needed.)

Compilation & Review – Next Steps

- Questions from the Board of Education and community are welcome as we move through the process
- > Budget email to gather community data and feedback budget@wcsdny.org
- ➤ Attending local Town and Village meetings to gather budget feedback
- > Information sharing process with local municipalities through quarterly meetings
- > Information sharing process with the community
 - Several Superintendent Forums to share budget building knowledge
 - State Mandated Budget Public Hearing on May 8, 2023

Building & Finalizing a Budget

- > Build components of the budget:
 - ➤ General Support, Instruction, Transportation & Undistributed
- > Utilize BOE and community feedback to refine the budget document
- > Respond to information as provided by New York State and other funding sources
- > Provide pertinent information to the BOE and community that is clear and concise
- > Continuously work with Administrative team to refine data and estimates used
- > Final Step Evaluate and reflect on the budgetary process
