2023-2024 New York State Budget & Aid

- ➤ On Monday, April 10, 2023, the District received information that the legislature approved a second budget extender to April 17th (source: NYSSBA Advocacy Update email).
- ➤ What does this mean?
 - The Board of Education is still scheduled to approve a Proposed Budget on April 17, 2023.
 - All information received from NYS by the District will be reviewed immediately upon receipt.
 - Any adjustments to the WCSD budget will be made based on:
 - previous conversations with the Board of Education and the community
 - Board of Education wish list items
 - community feedback
 - administration input
 - A revised presentation may be provided to the Board of Education at the April 17, 2023 meeting.
 - NYS aid comprises 33% of the District's total revenue at this time. It is anticipated that any changes to NYS aid can be managed to meet the 1.67% tax levy increase.

WCSD Continued Goal:

The 2023-2024 WCSD tax levy increase will be 1.67%, which is below the tax cap.

2023-2024 Additional Requests Capital Improvement Committee

The WCSD Capital Improvement Committee discussed the usage of General Fund fund balance dollars for infra-structure work around the District not to exceed \$500,000.
