Section 110 of the Workers' Compensation Law states: if an employee sustains a compensable injury and this injury does not result in permanent disability or loss of time more than one day beyond the work day or shift, and requires no more than two medical visits, the employer can elect to pay the medical bill at Workers' Compensation rates and is not required to file a report.

Similarly, Section 13-d of the Workers' Compensation Law provides that, in such situations, a physician's report does not need to be filed with Workers' Compensation Board or insurance carrier.

If the injury/illness, sustained by this employee, meets the requirements of Section 110 (as noted above) we will promptly pay your bill for medical service upon submission of your fee statement and medical report.
