Did you know?

The average high school graduation rate for students concentrating in CTE programs is 93%, compared to an average national freshman graduation rate of 80%.

More than 75% of secondary CTE concentrators pursued postsecondary education shortly after high school.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Students who take just one career and technical education course above the average are:

- More likely to graduate
- Enroll in a **two-year college**
- Be **employed and earn higher wages**
- Just as likely to enroll in a four-year college
