Transportation Requirements and Information

Bus Transportation: Bus transportation will be provided to and from the exams. For **AM** exams, the bus will **leave** John Jay High School at **7:30 AM** and return when exams finish. For **PM** exams, the bus will **leave** the high school at **11:15 AM**. Afternoon buses will return to both high schools at 3:30 pm. *Please* arrange for pick up at the school or you can take the late bus home if you return on time.

Self Drive: We are offering this option to students and families. Please see the arrival times below. Late entry is **not permitted**. *If you are late you will be denied entry and registered for the alternate date. Test administration can not be held up for late arrivals*.

*Students are expected to stay for the entirety of the testing time. Pick-up time varies based on start time. Students *will not be able to text their parents*. If a student's ride is not available at pick-up time, they will be brought to the school. **Students who elect to use** *extended time* **must secure alternate transportation.**

If there is an extenuating circumstance that necessitates a switch to the second administration, or should you wish to cancel your exam, please be in touch with your AP Teacher who will instruct you on how to proceed.

What to Bring to the AP In-Person Exam

- A charged District Issued Chromebook w/ a charger. (Amazon Link for Chromebook Charger)
- **Update for the 2025 AP Exams:** For all exams that allow or require calculators, except *AP Statistics*, students can use the built-in Desmos graphing calculator through the Bluebook testing application (*or approved personal calculator*). Note that for Calculus AB, Calculus BC, and Precalculus, Desmos will only be available in the calculator-required parts of the exam. Visit CollegeBoard.com to learn more about the calculator policy for upcoming exams.
- Identification, school ID or other government-issued ID. If you lost your school ID, coordinate with your school counselor to get a copy from our database.
- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- Analog watch (one with hands, not a smartwatch)
- A ruler or straightedge only if you're taking an AP Physics Exam.
- Water, and a light snack. There is a short break provided.

What not to bring to the AP In-Person Exam

- Smartwatches, cellular phones, pagers, MP3 players, or personal digital assistants (PDAs). Any and all of these items must be relinquished to the proctor before the exam can begin.
- Books, compasses, colored pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above).
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Portable listening or recording devices (even with headphones) or photographic equipment.

Testing Accommodations

• Testing accommodations must be pre-approved by the College Board's Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD). Students who have already submitted a request for College Board testing accommodations, including for PSAT or SAT, do not need to apply again. See your school counselor if you need to apply or if you have any questions.

Important Reminders

- You got this! Remember, you've worked hard to get here. Relax and believe in yourself.
- Heed the advice from your parents and teachers: Rest, and eat well.
- Be on your best behavior. School rules apply.
- Be on time. We will not hold an exam for late arrivals; you will be moved to the next administration.
