Welcome to Algebra 2 with Mrs. Lahey

Course: M551 Credit: 1

<u>Prerequisite:</u> Successful completion of Geometry with a final average of 70% or higher OR

Algebra 2N with a final average of 85% or higher with a teacher recommendation

<u>Course Description</u>: The Algebra 2 course includes the full Common Core Algebra 2 curriculum and your child will take the New York State Common Core Regents Exam at the conclusion of this school year. Topics include polynomials, equations, types of functions, exponents, identities, trig functions, statistics, probability, and much more.

<u>Materials:</u> - pens or pencils, large 3 ring binder that will only be used for Math, loose leaf paper, and the free graphing calculator app "Calculate84" or "calculator x"should be downloaded to all devices to use for homework.

<u>Homework Policy:</u> There is homework almost every night and it is expected to be completed. Homework will be checked for completeness and is worth 1 point. If it is incomplete, 1/2 credit will be awarded. We will go over the homework at the beginning of each period. Students should come prepared with their work and be ready to ask any questions they may have on that topic. Late homework is not accepted (unless absent) and will receive a score of zero.

Quizzes: Every 4 to 5 days there will be a quiz and the students will know about these quizzes in advance. Short pop quizzes will also be given. Quizzes range from 10 – 40 points.

Exit Tickets: An exit ticket consists of one or two problems given and collected at the end of class to show understanding of the daily lesson. These will be given periodically and will be graded. Exit tickets range from 2 - 10 points each.

Exams: There is one cumulative exam at the end of each quarter. Exams are worth 100 points.

Attendance Policy: For every day a student is absent, that is the amount of days they will have to make up the material and missing assignments. The student is responsible for all missed work. If a student is absent on a test day the student is responsible for setting up a time with me to take the test. Tests may be made up during the student's free period or during class if they do not have a lunch or study hall. Students are also responsible for any notes missed due to an absence. If a student skips a class all homework, tests, and quizzes that are due on that day will receive a grade of zero.

Students are expected to be in their seat when the late bell rings. Any work missed due to a tardy can not be made up.

- The first tardy, students will receive a warning.
- The second tardy, students will receive a lunch detention.
- The third tardy and any subsequent tardies a referral will be issued and an after school detention will be assigned.

<u>Cell Phones and Electronic Devices</u> - These items distract students from learning and they are not allowed to be out during class. Students will be asked to put their cell phones into a numbered storage

pouch at the beginning of each class period and they will remain there until the end of the period. When the bell rings the students can retrieve their phones and go to their next class.

The Student Code of Conduct states, "Any student who knowingly possesses a smart device on his/her person during an instructional period without permission, will be considered insubordinate and subject to the Student Code of Conduct"

During this math class smart devices are not permitted.

Grades: A student's average is based on total points. A students' average is updated every week and available to see in their Google Classroom at all times. There should never be any surprises regarding where a student stands and how they are progressing in the class.
