



**John Jay High School Chapter
Math Honor Society
Academic Integrity Policy**

The John Jay Math Honor Society values academic integrity and expects honesty, fairness, respect, and responsibility from each member. Maintaining respect for the ideas of others will create a positive learning environment in John Jay High School and encourage honest academic excellence. Any form of academic dishonesty, including cheating, copying, plagiarism, and unethical collaboration, will be punished.

The following list of violations is categorized according to the intensity of the offense. Each offense will be given the established amount of points. Each member will be warned after receiving a point. In the case that a student accumulates five (5) points, the student will be expelled from the honor society. A student that wishes to obtain commended or distinguished membership must have zero (0) points throughout his/her high school career. Points will roll over from year to year.

Violations

One Point:

- Allowing another student to copy homework or classwork.
- Collaborations on work assigned for independent completion.

Two Points:

- Copying another student's homework, classwork, or any other material to be checked.
- Intentional plagiarism from a resource without citation.
- Obtaining information concerning an exam from another student prior to taking the exam.
- Giving another student test answers prior to the student's examination.

Four Points:

- Cheating during a test, quiz, or other major examination. Instances of cheating include, but are not limited to, taking others' answers or methods, looking at notes during closed-book tests, and use of electronic devices for assistance during a test.
- Knowingly allowing a classmate to copy or cheat during an examination.
- Buying or selling completed projects, outlines, labs, or other assignments.

In the event that a student is caught with any of the above offenses, s/he will be subject to consequences of the Honor Society in addition to any punishment given by the teacher.

If a student violates two or more of the above offenses for one assignment, the offense with the highest number of points will be recorded.
